Staff Reference Assistance to Offsite Researchers is available by appointment and is billed at the following rates: One hour of the curator's time is allotted without charge for answering each reference request. There is a prepaid non-refundable research fee of: \$40.00 for the first hour thereafter and \$30 for each additional hour after that. Museum member rate for research is \$25.00 for the first hour and \$15.00 for each additional half hour.

High Resolution Scanning Fees: are \$15.00 per new scan or \$5 per existing digital stream/FTP upload.

Review Photo DVDs of approx. 15,000 low-resolution Johnson images are \$10.00 plus domestic shipping and they must be returned at the end of the project.

Archival copy fee: \$.50 per page for text or letters, \$5.00 per page for high res review photograph/poster copies
